This is totally unac-



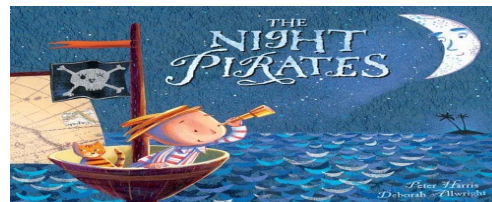
## ADVICE ON PARKING
