SPORTS

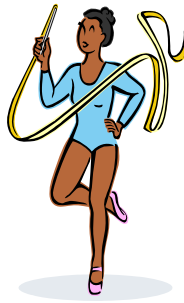

Your child has designed a Christmas card a few weeks ago and the card designs have finally arrived.

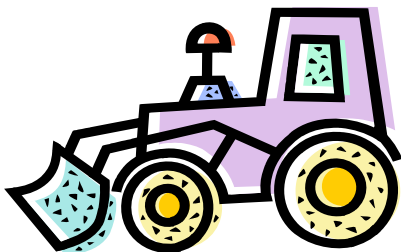
