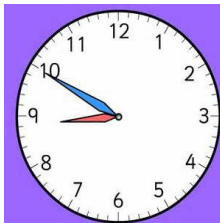

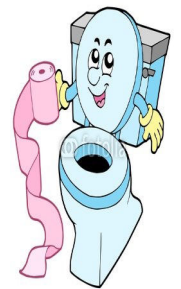
## SUMMER FAIR
