Dear Parents

For2feet Ltd have been asked by Enfield Council, to provide scooter training for children in Years 2 & 3. This will take place at Garfield school on Wednesday 8th October.

Scooter training is a great way to encourage children to scoot to school safely. To participate the children must have a scooter.

The children will receive one 40-45 minute training session. This is split into 15 minutes on the playground and 25-30 minutes on the pavement around the school.

Training includes Balance, Leg swapping, Safe road crossing and Scootering hazards.

The children will be trained in groups of 10, with 2 trainers.

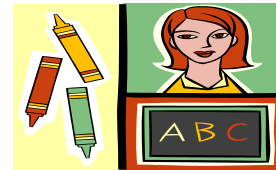
The school requires your permission to allow your child to participate in this training. Permission slips are included on a letter being given out separately. This needs to be returned urgently.
