We also said goodbye to Ms Marshall our Singing Teacher who is leaving to have a baby.

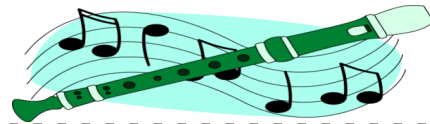
