I hope you all read the important letter going home today in your child's book bag. There is some important information about the new school building and our projected move in date.

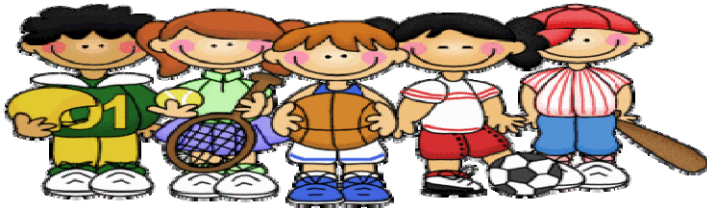

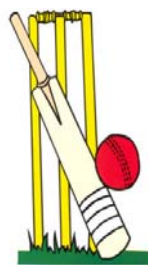
SPORTS WEEK
