We now have **5** days left in our current school before our week's closure on 23rd-27th May.

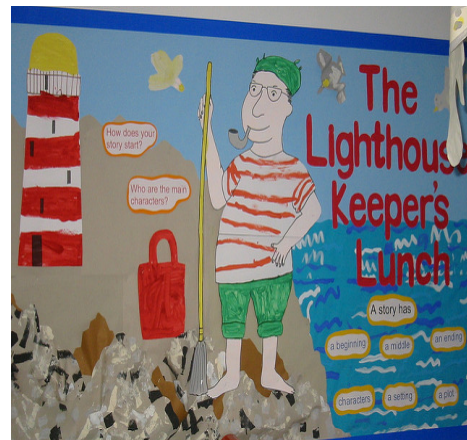
