### Maths

It would be very helpful for you to encourage your children to engage in every day maths for example; count items in shopping baskets, recognise family ages and birthdays and look for numbers in the environment.

### Clothing

Please dress your child in suitable clothing for the weather on that day. For example: on cold days they will need warm clothes, gloves, hat and scarf; on hot days, a sun hat.

**At all times**, please make sure your child is wearing sensible, well fitting shoes which they can take on and off, do up by themselves and which are suitable for running and climbing
