

English

In English this half term, we will be reading 'Roman Invasion (My Story)' by Jim Eldridge to inspire our writing. We will be writing a newspaper report about Boudicca's rebellion and a historical recount about Britain's invasion by Claudius. We will be identifying themes, asking questions and retelling stories orally during our reading lessons. Please ensure you are reading at home every night to help with your fluency.

Maths

In maths this half term, we will begin by focusing on mental strategies in addition and subtraction and place value. We will be focusing on learning and using multiplication and division facts in solving more advanced problems. We will be learning how to tell the time and calculate time intervals. Lastly, we will focus on written addition and subtraction methods.

Science

In science this half term we will be learning about sound. We will be investigating how different materials can affect the pitch and volume of sound. We will compare sources of sound and explain how the sounds differ. We will be finding patterns between the pitch of a sound and the object that produce it. We will be able to recognise and explain why sound gets fainter and louder according to distance.



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Topic

In our topic lessons this half term we will be doing geography, history and art.

In geography we will be learning about local changes over time. We will be finding the same places on a globe, in an atlas and in aerial photographs. Then we will label what we can see and how it has changed.

In history we will be finding out about how the Roman invasion has helped to shape our lives today. We will be sequencing events that have happened in British history. We will also learn about Boudicca's rebellion and compare the lives of an Emperor to a Celt.

In art we will be learning about drawing. We will begin by learning how to draw simple objects (a Roman shield) using marks and lines to produce texture. We will then be learning how to use line, tone, shape and colour to draw a moving person (a Roman soldier during battle).
