Dear Parents and Carers,

School Reopening, Monday 8th March 2021 – Reminders of Key Information

The school has been busy planning for March when we will welcome back all our pupils full time, from Monday to Friday, in their normal class groups.

We have been preparing for these changes by changing our daily systems and procedures to ensure the school is as safe as possible for children, parents, and staff.

We have updated our Parent Booklet to give details of how this will work and a copy of the booklet is available on the school website under the tab 'Parents' Information'.

There are nine main 'need to knows' for parents:

1. ***Don't send your child to school if they are unwell – see revised flow chart attached to this email on the procedures to follow if your child or anyone in your household develops Covid symptoms or has a positive test***
2. ***All children should be wearing full school uniform.***
3. ***No PE kits will be stored in school - children wear PE kit all day on their PE day.***
4. ***Bring a refillable water bottle every day.***
5. ***Children can bring in book bags with their reading book and homework.***
6. ***Children must not bring in any equipment (such as pencil cases) or toys.***
7. ***Staggered start and finish times:***
 - ***Nursery: 8:30am to 11:30am***
 - ***Reception, years 1 and 2: 8:40am to 3:05pm***
 - ***Years 3 and 4: 8:50am to 3:15pm***
 - ***Years 5 and 5: 9am to 3:25pm***
8. ***Separate entrances for different year groups:***
 - ***Springfield Road: Reception, Year 1, Year 2: Year 3 and 4 (home time only)***
 - ***Upper Park Road: Year 3, Year 4, Year 5, Year 6, access to the school office.***
 - ***See map attached to this email for details of where to drop-off and pick-up your child***
9. ***All parents MUST wear a face mask, fully covering their mouth and nose, when they are dropping off and picking up, unless they are exempt for a medical reason.***

Members of the senior team will be available at the beginning and end of each day to help parents and ensure a smooth transition.
