Complaints Procedure – Additional Information updated April 2022

We have adopted the Borough's clear complaints procedure. You can also find this on our website. It is always helpful to firstly attempt to resolve an issue via your child's class teacher (if appropriate).

If this is not possible, the next stage would be to try to resolve the matter with the relevant Achievement Leader (linked to your child's phase).

If the matter is still unresolved, then a letter needs to be sent to the Headteacher.

The Head has devised a sheet to log and record any parental complaints and also analyse if they were resolved. We have very few complaints at Garfield as we try to be preventative and keep good communication with parents.
