Summer 1 topic: How are the Caribbean Islands and the UK similar?



<b>WORD</b>	<b>MEANING</b>
<b>Human features</b>	Something built by humans and not existing naturally
<b>Physical features</b>	Natural features on the surface of the Earth such as rivers, seas, mountains and deserts
<b>Economic features</b>	Associated with wealth and income; the production, distribution and consumption of goods and services
<b>Commodity</b>	A raw material or primary agricultural product that can be bought and sold
<b>Environment</b>	Surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal or plant lives and operates
<b>Land use</b>	The function of land and what it is used for, including: agriculture, recreation, commerce, residence and transport
<b>Rural</b>	An open area of land with few homes or other buildings and a small population
<b>Urban</b>	A built-up area with many homes and other buildings and a high population. These include towns and cities
<b>Population</b>	The number of inhabitants who live in a particular place
