

English

In English this half term we will be reading lots of traditional tales and fairy tales. We will be labelling things we see in pictures from Goldilocks and the Three Bears, writing lists for story characters and writing captions for pictures from Little Red Riding Hood.

We will then be retelling and writing our own version of The Gingerbread Man. We will be learning to use 'and' to join two clauses in a sentence.

Maths

In maths we will be counting and ordering numbers to 10 and beyond. We will explore how numbers are represented and represent them in a variety of ways. We will be finding one more and one less including on a number line. We will use language such as 'less than', 'greater than' and 'equal to' and compare numbers. Science

In science this half term we will be learning about the season of autumn by observing changes we can see as summer fades away. We will be talking about the weather and how it can vary in different places around the world.

We will also be naming parts of the human body we can and cannot see whilst linking them to our five senses. We will expand our scientific vocabulary.

RE

In RE this half term we will be learning about Judaism. We will find out how Jewish children learn about God through their families, home life and festivals.

PSHE

Geography
