

English

Our literacy for this term will be linked to our topic on the **Ancient Egyptians**.

The first writing task will be to retell the myth of Osiris and Isis, we will retell the myth verbally and then draft, edit and improve and publish our finished piece of writing.

The second writing task will be to write descriptive poetry linked to Egyptian myths. We will be learning how to use alliterations, similes and descriptive language.

Children need to read every day and try some of the books on our suggested reading list.

Maths

We will identify different methods for dividing numbers (sharing and grouping) and use this knowledge in different contexts.

We will be learning multiplication and division facts this term. Pupils will build their knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and then move on to the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

Pupils will apply their multiplication and division skills for a range of problem solving.

Science


Our science topic is 'Animals including Humans.'

We will learn about living things and their needs. We will also learn about different feeding groups and how to describe the role of different food groups in the body.

We be learning about our bones and the bones in animal bodies. In particular, we will be learning to identify and know the function of the main bones in our body.

PE: Tuesday & Thursday

RE

Our main focus for this half-term will be Hinduism in which we will make connections between Hindu belief in one God and the diverse forms in which God is worshipped e.g. Krishna, Rama, Lakshmi and Ganesha.

PSHE

We will be learning about the importance of keeping safe. We will be learning how to keep safe in different situations including school, at home and on the roads. There will also be a focus on internet safety and bullying.

French (KS2 only)

Our main aim is to learn and use words relating to the classroom environment in French. We will explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link to the spelling, sound and meaning of words.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about mountains. We will learn what mountains are and why people live on them. We will learn about different mountain regions and about Snowdonia in particular.

Music

We will be learning how to read simple notation on the treble stave and reading simple melodies. We will develop our sight reading by playing 'Samba CA' and ending the term by performing all of our pieces we have learnt to play.

ART/DT

In D&T, the children will be making mummies—linked to our history topic on Ancient Egypt. The children will have fun, planning, designing and making their own mummies!

Computing

We will be learning about online safety. Remember to **stay safe** online and find out how the internet works and how websites are made. Can you research the Ancient Egyptians and make a PowerPoint presentation by compiling all the facts you have found out?
