- Inform children and parents/carers what the teachers aim to teach the children each half term;
- Welcome everyone and offer the chance for parents/carers to become involved in the daily life of the school;
- Have a clear, consistent and fair approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text messages, the website and general meetings.

#### To help my child at school, I will do my best to:

- Support all staff in their efforts to create a caring community which values children;
- Make sure that my child attends school regularly: please note that holidays are not permitted during term time;
- Make sure that my child is on time every day, arriving at 8.50am and collecting at 3.15pm (11.30am for nursery);
- Inform the school on the first day of absence by 10am;
- Make sure my child wears correct school uniform every day and her/his PE kit on their class' PE day;
- Tell the school about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's ability to learn or behave well;
- Support the school to make sure my child behaves well and follows the school guidelines for behaviour;
- Make sure my child reads every day and record their reading in their reading diary;
- Support my child with homework and other home learning opportunities;
- Attend parent meetings with the teacher to discuss my child's achievements, progress and targets;
- Support the school in getting any help my child may need;
- Read all letters/text messages/emails that are sent home;
- Inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer emergency contacts details;
- Provide appropriate healthy food if my child brings a packed lunch into school;
- My child must not bring any items into school with them, or take items home from school, apart from their book bag with their reading book and homework, their packed lunch in their lunch box and a water bottle;
- I will make sure my child brings into school a water bottle that they
  can refill at the class sink. This bottle must be clearly labelled with the
  child's name.

#### I will do my best to:

- Follow the Garfield Values;
- Come to school regularly and on time;
- Learn and improve in all areas of my work;
- Work hard, try my best at all times and listen carefully to instructions;
- · Follow the school and class rules;
- Behave well at all times so that everyone is safe;
- Be polite, friendly and helpful to other children and all adults;
- Tell somebody if there is something I am not happy about;
- Do my homework regularly and return it to school on time;
- Read every day at home, either to an adult or myself, and record my reading in my reading diary;
- Bring all the equipment I need every day including my PE kit, book bag and reading books;
- Take good care of the school environment and look after all school equipment;
- Not bring things into school from home, or take any things home from school, apart from my book bag with my reading book and homework, my water bottle and packed lunch;
- Bring into school a water bottle that I can refill at the class sink.
